DUTIES/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Supervise groups of children.
- Provide care, guidance, and developmental experiences, meeting the appropriate educational and emotional needs of the children.
- Give each child individual specialized attention each day, responding to each child's particular needs and characteristics.
- Provide and assist in personal hygiene practices, including toileting issues, as necessary. It is not our policy to change diapers, but we will assist in potty accident clean up.
- Help keep records of any daily information, such as parent sign in and out, accident reporting and calls home.

- Provide enriching and high quality educational experiences to young learners.
- Attend monthly staff meetings and quarterly trainings.
